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Proceedings of the 2nd meeting of the West Bengal State Social Security Board held on 25.02.2011 in the chamber of the Hon'ble Minister-in-Charge, Labour Department, Writers' Buildings, Kolkata – 700 001.

The Hon'ble Minister-in-Charge, Labour Department took the chair and welcomed the members present. He thanked the members for being present in the meeting in spite of their busy schedule. A copy of a statement of bank accounts of the "West Bengal Transport Workers' Social Security Fund" was circulated among the members for information showing a clear balance of Rs.1,82,72,846/- as on 19.02.2011. A copy of the statement of registration of beneficiaries under the West Bengal Transport Workers' Social Security Scheme, 2010 was also circulated showing a total of 37,306 beneficiaries as on 31.01.2011.

The proceedings of the first meeting of the Board dated 02.08.2010 was confirmed.

It was observed by the Addl. Chief Secretary and Member Secretary that there should be a separate set of employees for the board. However, after a detailed discussion it was resolved that the labour commissioner shall provide for the required personnel for the time being and shall also propose for creation of suitable posts in the ranks of Additional Labour Commissioner, Joint Labour Commissioner, Deputy Labour Commissioners, Assistant Labour Commissioners, inspectors, clerks and group D staffs.

The Chief Executive Officer under the West Bengal Transport Workers' Social Security Scheme, 2010 then placed the draft annual budget under the West Bengal Transport Workers' Social Security Scheme, 2010 for consideration of the Board. After a thorough discussion it was adopted with a few modifications. The budget so adopted is presented as an annexure to the proceedings.

In the process of finalization of the budget it was resolved that the office of the CEO of the scheme shall be permitted to hire a vehicle on monthly basis under observation of rules and regulations in such matters. It was also resolved that the CEO shall be permitted to incur an expenditure of up to Rs. 1 lac only towards renovation of the top floor of the office from where the scheme is being operated presently.

After threadbare discussions, the following matters / issues were also resolved:

- The Government will be moved for giving permission to open district-wise bank account in the name of the "District Transport Workers' Social Security Fund Administrative" for smooth administration of the West Bengal Transport Workers' Social Security Scheme, 2010.
- Chief Accounts Officer and Additional Chief Executive Officer, Kolkata are made permanent invitees in the Executive Council.
- Md. Amanul Haque is appointed as the Chief Executive Officer under the W.B.T.W.S.S scheme, 2010 w.e.f. the date he had assumed charge.

There being no further issue to discuss, the meeting ended with thanks to and from the chair.
